Your organization agrees to show these grant funds separately on its books; however, your organization is not required to segregate these funds in separate bank accounts. All expenditures made for the purposes of the grant shall appear on those books, and your organization agrees to make such books and records available to the Tides Foundation at reasonable times upon request. Your organization also agrees to keep copies of all books, records, and reports to Tides for at least four years after completion of the use of the funds.
